

## **St. Anthony Summer Program - June 28<sup>th</sup> - August 6<sup>th</sup>**

### **Kindergarten Readiness 8:30 - 11:30**

Students enjoy practicing language arts and math skills. Daily activities involve the alphabet, sounds, writing skills, number recognition, number writing, patterns, and more.

### **Grade 1/2 - Fun with Math 8:30 - 9:20**

Review basic math skills using hands-on activities and games. Students will learn and review addition, subtraction, money, time, problem solving, and word problems.

### **Grade 1/2 - Imagination and Inspiration 9:25 - 10:15**

Students will delight in beginning reading practice as they enjoy a variety of genres such as fiction, nonfiction, poetry, rhyme, and fairy tales. Students will identify different story elements and build writing skills.

### **Grade 1/2 - Science Discovery 10:30 - 11:30**

Students explore the world of science as they investigate through the eyes of scientist.

### **Grade 3/4 - Skills and Thrills 8:30 - 9:20**

Improve basic math skills while having fun! Students will learn through hands-on activities, various math skills including addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, problem solving, and word problems.

### **Grade 3/4 - Book Writing 9:25 - 10:15**

Students will learn about the process of writing a children's book as they explore the elements of literature. They will make important decisions that affect the overall outcome of the book. Students will illustrate pictures, create the story, and celebrate the release of a bound book.

### **Grade 3/4 - Weird and Wacky Science 10:30 - 11:30 T/TH**

Students understand basic scientific principles through exploration and hands-on activities.

### **Grade 3/4 Sail the Seas 10:30 - 11:30 M/W**

Students will become members of teams sent by a cruise line to explore different international travel destinations. Each week team members will embark on different exotic destination and discover new cultures through food, geography, history, and music.

### **Grade 5/6 - Literature & Writing 8:30 - 9:50**

Explore short stories across literary genres while developing writing skills. Each week will focus on a new story with discussions of character, plot, and themes, exploring the global and literary worlds through narrative, expository, persuasive, and descriptive writing. Students will preview operations in Algebra: writing/solving equations; simplifying variable expressions; positive and negative exponents; graphing in the coordinate plane
